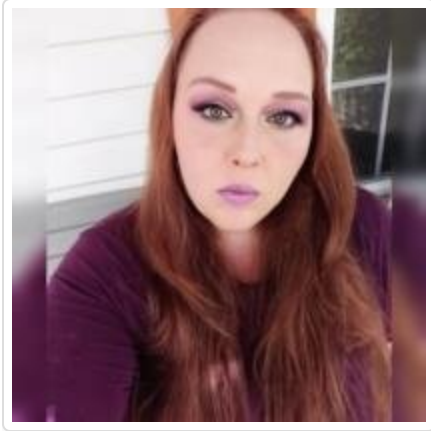




Amanda Christi Allen
