Betty Bennett Canady, 88, of Newnan passed away Thursday, September 2, 2021 at Ansley Park Health & Rehabilitation. Betty was born November 12, 1932 in Sargent, GA to the late Bass Bennett & Zela Jones Bennett. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her beloved husband of 43 years, Harold Canady.

Betty grew up in Hogansville where she was a gifted basketball player at Hogansville High School.
