Bradley Eric Kjar, age 51, of Newnan, GA, passed away on June 18, 2022. He was born on February 2, 1971, in Ida Grove, Iowa, to Linnea Kjar-Hopp, and the late Larry Kjar.

Brad grew up in Waverly, Iowa, and graduated from Waverly-Shell Rock Senior Highschool in 1989. He attended the University of Iowa, graduating in 1993 with a bachelor degree in communications. Brad later received a Master of Business Administration in 2005.

Brad was a creative and innovative team builder in the corporate car rental industry for 20 years. At the time of death, Brad was serving as General Manager with Sedgwick Corporate Services in Atlanta. 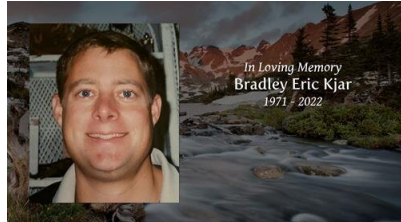

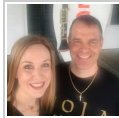
