He was born February 7, 1925 in Overland, Missouri to the late Florence Christensen Hoppe and Carl William Hoppe. Unfortunately, he lost both of his parents when he was only two years old. He eventually took a path that led him to Eastern Airlines. He had a long and successful career during the golden years of aviation and also got to do a job he absolutely loved. He retired from Eastern as a Captain. Throughout his life he found great enjoyment, while on the ground, as an accomplished golfer. Surviving Chris is his loving wife of 34 years, Pat Alford Christensen; a son, Carl Hoppe Christensen (Helene) of Columbus, TX.
