After spending 3 years living in Germany, she and her family moved back to Detroit where she would continue her childhood and education before moving to Columbus, OH at the age of 30 with her two sons. After spending 6 years developing her professional skills in Columbus, she relocated back to Detroit, MI and spent an additional 10 years there before ultimately settling in Las Vegas NV.

Carolyn was baptized and accepted Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior at an early age in New Grace Missionary Baptist Church under the pastoral leadership of the late Rev. Julius C. Hope. While living in Las Vegas, she chose Unity Baptist Church as her new church home where she invested time in becoming an active member and developing relationships throughout the ministry. 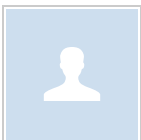
