Charles Eugene Bryant, Ed.D., Major, U.S. Air Force, Command Pilot (Ret.) died on August 16th, 2019. He was 90 years old. He passed away in the home and loving care of his daughter, Camilla Jean. He had battled multiple ailments. His grandson, Luke, was by his side when he passed to Heaven.

He was the second born son of Morton Hodgson Bryant and Jeanette (Nettie Jane) Norton Bryant. His "Aunt Fanny" Alexander attended his birth in Corner, Alabama on 1 January 1929 and lived with the family until he was 14 years old.
