



David Lynn Shefelton

August 1, 1932 - July 14, 2025

Mr. David Lynn Shefelton, 92, of Newnan, passed away Monday, July 14, 2025, at Southland Health & Rehabilitation. He was born August 1, 1932, in Alliance, Ohio, to the late William Earl Shefelton & Margery Lynn Shefelton. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Mary Ellen Shefelton, and his granddaughter, Kristy Shefelton.

David and his family moved to Newnan in the early 1930s, and he grew up there. He was a graduate of Newnan High School in 1950. He was a proud graduate of Alabama Polytechnic Institute in Auburn, Alabama. He was a member of the Kappa Alpha Order fraternity. After college, he joined the United States Army Corps of Engineers. He worked for International Playtex for 39 years. He was a longtime member of First Baptist Church of Newnan, serving as a Deacon of the church for many years.

The visitation will be held at 3:00 p.m. on Friday, July 18, 2025, at the First Baptist Church of Newnan, 15 West Washington Street, Newnan, in the historic sanctuary. The funeral will be directly after 4:00 PM in the historic sanctuary, with Rev. Lee Chitwood officiating. Interment will take place at Oak Hill Cemetery, 96 Jefferson Street, Newnan, GA 30263.

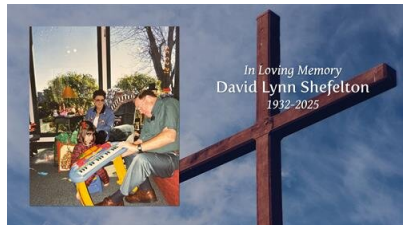
