Delaine Doris Jantzen, 82, of Sharpsburg, Georgia, passed away on September 29, 2023 in Newnan, Georgia. There will be no services.

Delaine Doris (Neuharth) Jantzen daughter of Fred and Edna (Schnabel) Neuharth was born February 27, 1941 in Eureka, South Dakota. She was raised on the family farm northwest of Eureka, South Dakota.
