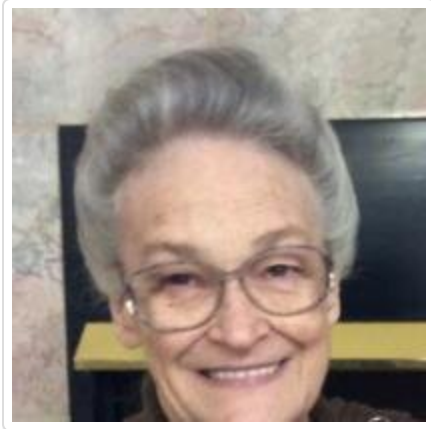




Dorothy Henrietta McGaha
