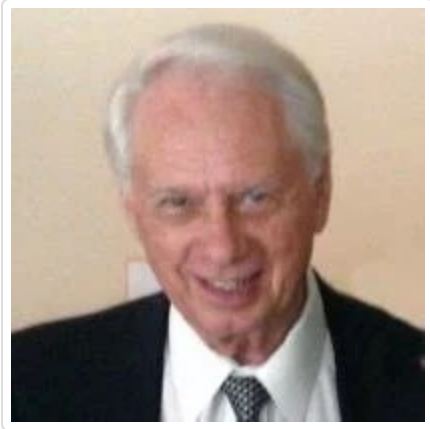




Dr. William Bryan Lee

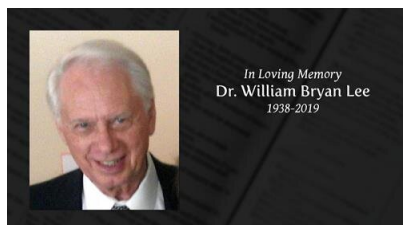

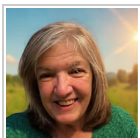

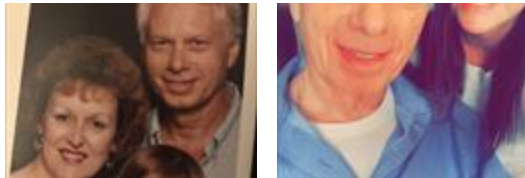
