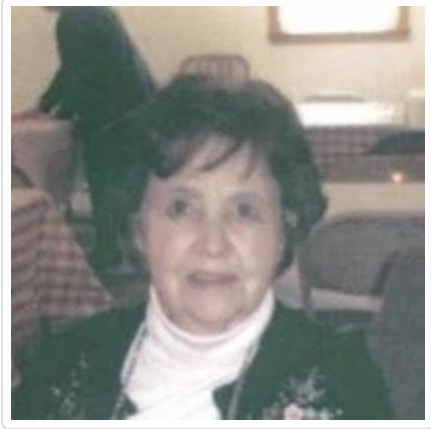




Eleanor Deane Rousseau
