July 12, 1931 - August 13, 2015

Evelyn Wade McCurry, age 84 of Newnan, passed away Thursday, August 13, 2015 at Cancer Treatment Centers of America. She was born July 12, 1931 in Atlanta, GA to the late James Wade and Clara Hale Wade. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by daughters Patricia Anne McCurry and Hannah Elizabeth McCurry; grandchildren, Matthew McCurry and Amber Schroeder.

Mrs. McCurry grew up in Atlanta where she met her husband and became sweethearts at age 12. They began their life together marrying at age 17. She and her husband founded Calvary Temple (Heritage Baptist Church) where he served as senior pastor for many years. Mrs. McCurry was an active pastor's wife serving in many capacities including church organist, secretary, and ministering alongside her husband. They moved the church from Atlanta to Sharpsburg in 1988 and later changed the name to Southpointe Church. She and her husband founded Central Christian School (Heritage Christian School) in 1965 where they made a difference in the lives of many children over the past 50 years.

The funeral is Monday, August 17, 2015 at 2 o'clock at SouthPointe Church, 3613 Highway 34 East, Sharpsburg, GA with Pastor John Weaver officiating. Burial will follow the service at Forest Lawn Memorial Park, Newnan. The visitation is Sunday evening between 6:00-8:00 at McKoon Funeral Home, 38 Jackson St, Newnan.
