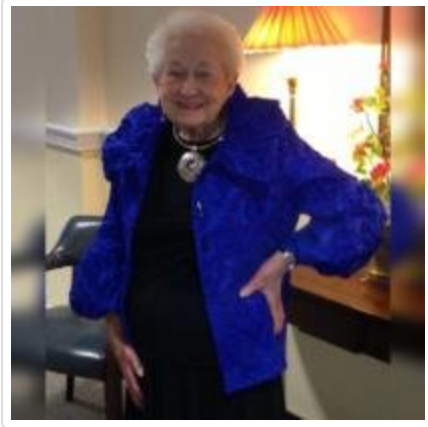




Frances Garrett Goodson

January 21, 1923 - April 1, 2024

Mrs. Frances Garrett Goodson, 101, of Newnan, GA passed away on Monday, April 1, 2024 at Wesley Woods of Newnan. She was born on January 21, 1923 in Roopville, GA to the late Barney Lee Garrett and Gussie Hay Garrett. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, A. Powers Goodson.

Frances grew up in Roopville, GA and was a 1941 graduate of Roopville High School. She graduated with a degree in education from the University of Alabama where she was a member and President of Alpha Chi Omega sorority. After college she married Powers Goodson and they built their home and raised their family in Franklin, GA. She was a school teacher for over 35 years and a member of Franklin United Methodist Church. She completed her Masters of Education from Auburn University and the 6-year certificate from West Georgia College.

After her husband passed away in 1993, she along with Lindsey and Genet Barron, were instrumental in bringing Wesley Woods to Newnan almost 30 years ago. From the day that it opened, Frances moved in and made a home there for the next 26 years. She was a member of Newnan First United Methodist Church and the Friendship Sunday School Class.
