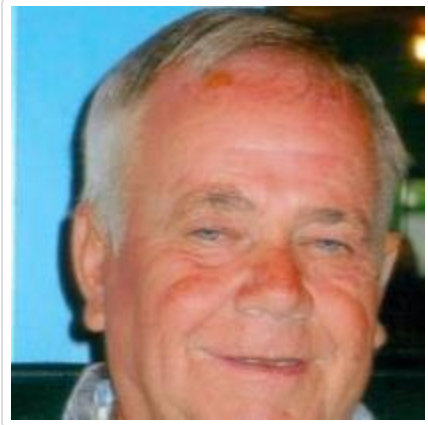




Freddie Monroe O'Neal Gann
