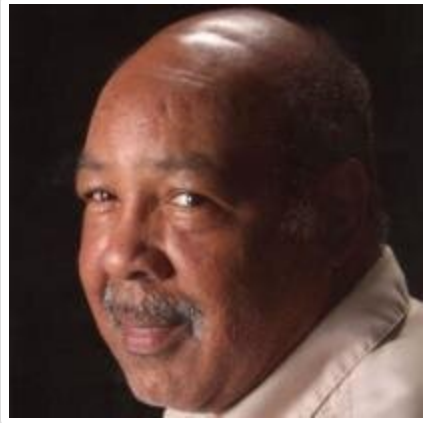




George Lambert Findlay, Jr.
