



## George Sidney Warren

May 31, 1922 - October 10, 2020

G. Sidney Warren, age 98, passed away peacefully on Saturday, October 10, 2020 at his home in Newnan surrounded by family. Sidney was born on May 31, 1922 in Newnan, GA to the late E. Paul and Emmie Witcher Warren.

Along with his parents, Sidney is preceded in death by brothers, Claude (Frances) Warren, Hoyt (Lucille) Warren, Wendell (Frances) Warren, Paul (Lorraine) Warren; sisters, Martha Warren (Ed) Whitlock and Sue Warren (George) Johnston. He is survived by his wife Virginia Copeland Warren; children, Chip (Patty) Warren, Cherry Warren (Floyd) Toney; grandchildren, Jonathan (Natalie) Warren, Katie Warren (Jon) O'Neal, Daniel and Adam Toney and great grandchildren, Sydney and Andrew Warren, Robert Finn O'Neal.

Mr. Warren served in WWII in the 612th Tank Destroyer Battalion as a sergeant, including action in the Battle of the Bulge. He was an active member of the First Baptist Church of Newnan, GA, serving as a deacon, Discipleship Training Director, and the media ministry.
