Howard "Rob" Robbins, 64, of Newnan, GA died Saturday, December 29, 2012. He was born April 7, 1948 to the late Howard King Robbins & Mabel Aileen McClure Robbins. He grew up living in several cities throughout Texas working in the oil field.

Rob was a Veteran having served a tour in Vietnam. It was in the Army that he was given the nickname Rob, which he went by the rest of his life. He enjoyed fishing as his favorite pastime.
