James Alfred "Jimmy" Carlisle, age 84 of Newnan passed away on Thursday, September 2, 2010 at Piedmont Newnan Hospital. He was born in Manchester, GA to the late William Joe Carlisle and Jessie Byrd Carlisle. Mr. Carlisle served in WWII as a Paratrooper in the 82nd Airborne and served in the Battle of the Bulge until he was wounded in action. Upon his return from service, he and his wife ran Carlisle's Wrecker Service and Texaco for 37 years. Mr. Carlisle was a member of Newnan First United Methodist Church.
