Leland Rogers, 86, of Sharpsburg died Tuesday, October 19, 2010 at VistaCare Hospice in Columbus. He was born February 19, 1924 in the Ephesus Community of Carroll County to the late William & Clara Lewis Rogers.

Mr. Rogers was a WWII Navy Veteran who served on the LST 542 ship where he participated in the D-Day Invasion. He retired from James River Co. as a press operator in 1986.

The funeral is Thursday, October 21, 2010 at 2:00 pm in the chapel of McKoon Funeral Home with Rev. F.D. McWhorter officiating. Burial will follow at Oak Hill Cemetery.
