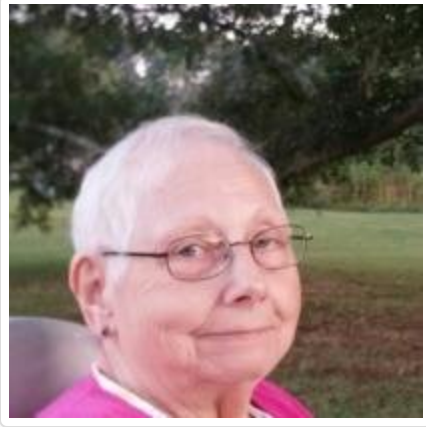




Louise Kee Brooks
