Nora C. Harbin Flynn, 56 of Fayetteville, GA passed away Saturday, September 18, 2021, at Piedmont Newnan Hospital. “ One of my favorite stories my mother would tell me, often, was the story of my birth. She was quite young, and nervous, and it wasn't without a few challenges. I was born on a cold January day, mid winter, in the upper peninsula of Michigan, when at 7 months pregnant my mom experienced amniotic fluid leakage, and pain. A quick doctor's visit and a tiny wait for results concluded she had no choice, and she was going to have to give birth that day. By the time she recieved the news she was home, it was evening and it was snowing. With snow at least 2 feet high, and temperatures so low, they couldn't get the car to start. Terrible timing, and since she knew there was no time to waste, she walked in the snow and feeezing temps! When she arrived at the hospital, the medical staff was in shock as they stared at a tired, soaking wet and very cold, determined pregnant woman. Immediately they started drying her up and getting her warm. Things moved pretty quickly once there and she was getting more nervous as the doc used words, like preemie, incubator, breathing problems, and nicu. But to everyones suprise, especially the doctors, I was born perfectly healthy. Praise Jesus! I didn't need an incubator or nicu or anything at all. She said the moment they put me in her arms all was right with the world. My mother held me for hours before she took off my hospital blanket to make sure I had all my fingers and toes. She said she was too scared to look or ask because everything else went so well, and she thought for sure, being a preemie, I was missing something.and we had many laughs over the years about this. (she DID ask the doctors Immediately after the births of my younger siblings) But at 17 years old, my mother told me that becoming a mother was the absolute best thing to happen to her, and that it saved her. Because caring for me meant she had a purpose in this world. This is the epitome of who my mom was to her core. A selfless woman. I will live all of the rest of my days trying to measure up.
