



## Raymond Graham

August 9, 1919 - June 8, 2010

Raymond W. Graham, a one year resident of Newnan, died June 8, 2010, at the age of 90. He and his wife moved to Wesley Woods in 2009 from Gainesville, Florida, where they had resided since 1952. Mr. Graham was an architect and was responsible for designing numerous public schools in Alachua County as well as the "new" Alachua General Hospital in Gainesville. He also taught architecture and building construction at the University of Florida, his alma mater. Before moving to Gainesville, he had worked in architectural firms in Leesburg, Florida, and Atlanta, Georgia. He served in the U.S. Navy during WWII.

Raymond was a gardener, a canner of vegetables and pickles and relishes, a lover of sports, art, wine. and gourmet food. He and his wife traveled extensively within the United States.
