



Rev. Charles Novak

June 28, 1946 - August 9, 2020

Charles Joseph Novak, 74, passed away peacefully at home on Sunday August the 9, 2020 at 4 am from home hospice care due to a severe stroke. He also struggled with cancer for the last decade of his life. He joined the Navy in 1965 and served for four years. He worked at Delta over the next 35 years, retiring to pastor for 10 years.

He was born June 28th, 1946 in Pittsburg, Pennsylvania to the late Joseph and Sara Novak. He was also preceded in death by his brother, Bob, as well as his daughter, Donna and several other family members.

Surviving are his wife, Flo, son, Terry, grandson, Ian, daughter, Patricia, son-in-law, Jason, granddaughter, Caitlyn, and dog, BooBoo. Also surviving are several aunts, cousins, nieces, and nephews.
