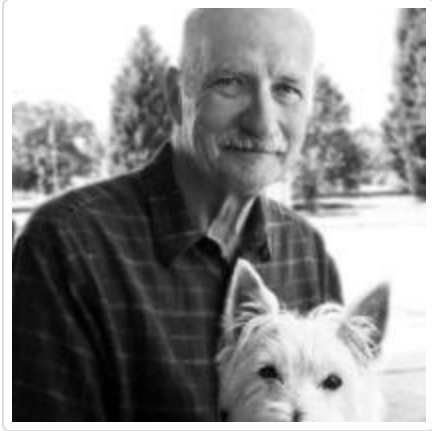




Rev. Richard W. McLeroy
