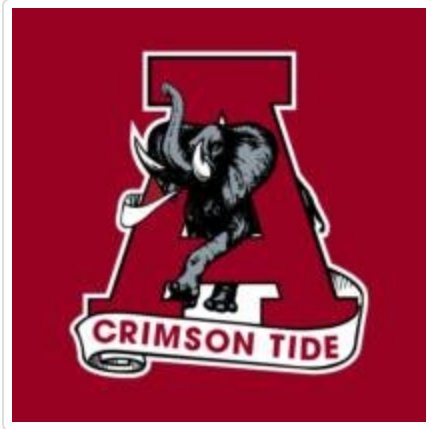




Richard "Dickie" Edward Arnold

Richard "Dickie" Edward Arnold, Jr., Age 67 passed away May 17, 2016 in Douglasville, GA at Douglasville Hospital after an extended illness related to injuries sustained during a car wreck in 1971. He was a member of the 1967 Class of Sigma Alpha Epsilon at the University of Alabama and a member of the Knights of Columbus. Shortly after graduation Richard was

seriously injured in an automobile accident and resuscitated. Although he suffered lifelong injuries, Richard was blessed with many friends and loved ones who helped him live an adventurous, active and fulfilling life. After dating Jeannie for 15 years, they married on Leap Year 1996. Richard was retired from the Metro Court System where he served as a Deputy Clerk.
