Richard Steve Hines, age 71, passed gently from this world on February 27, 2013 from complications of heart and lung disease. Steve was born January 9, 1942 of strong East Newnan Village stock and was the son of the Late Van L. "Doc" Hines, Jr. and Chloe Phillips Hines. He graduated from Newnan High School in 1960 and served four years in The United States Navy. Possessed of a strong work ethic instilled in him by his parents, he worked for Delta Airlines for 29 years as a parts foreman. Following his retirement from Delta, he worked for Playtex International and later for E. G. O. North America. He is survived by his wife of 48 years, Evelyn Wright Hines; his sons, Jeff (and Melissa) Hines, Phil (and Miachele) Hines. His brother is Mickey Hines. He was a proud grandfather to Heather (Zach) Heinberg, Drew Hines, Scott Hines, Connor Hines and Chloe Hines.
