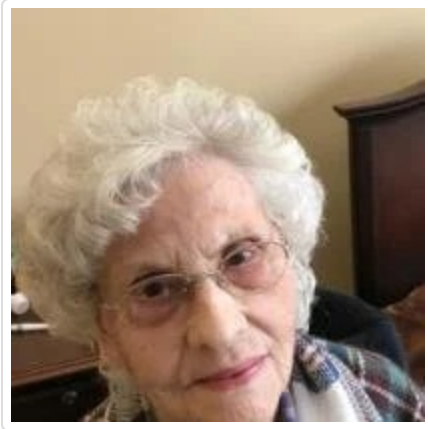




Sara Sue Stewart

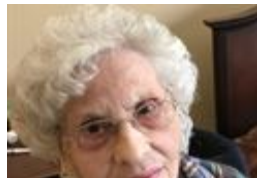
