Shirley Crawford Odom, 81, of Turin, Georgia was ushered into the arms of Jesus on Saturday, March 30, 2019.

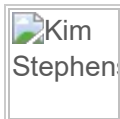

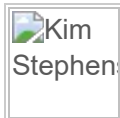
