Mrs. Victoria (Vickie) Lynn DeFoer, 69, of Newnan, formerly of Memphis, TN, passed away on Sunday, May 25, 2025 at Emory University Hospital after a short battle with cancer. She was born May 14, 1956 in Covington, Kentucky to the late Josephine Elsie Hardebeck (Preston) and Herman John Hardebeck, Sr.

Vickie grew up in Memphis, Tennessee, and graduated from Memphis State University. In Memphis, she worked in the payroll department at Holiday Inn. While working there, she met Kevin DeFoer, the love of her life, at Resurrection Catholic Church. Kevin and Vickie were married on May 21, 1988. They moved to Newnan in 1997, and Vickie worked for the Atlanta Journal-Constitution and ClubCorp. She retired in 2021. Kevin and Vickie have been members of St. George Catholic Church since 1997, where Vickie served as a Eucharistic Minister, Sacristan, and on the Finance Council.

Vickie was a kind, loving person who loved her family, relaxing on the front porch with her husband, camping in the RV, spending time at the beach, and her dogs. Since September 2024, Vickie spent a good deal of time at their retirement home in Melbourne Beach, Florida and couldn't wait until Kevin retired so they could live there full-time.
