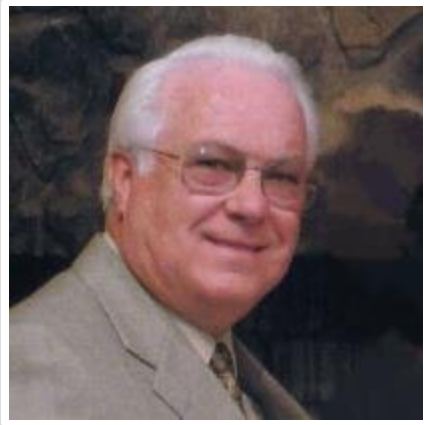




Wayne Hoyt Kiser
