May 9, 1920 - March 6, 2009

William Earnest Jones died on Friday, March 6, 2009 at Wesley Woods of Newnan-Peachtree City. Mr. Jones was born on May 9, 1920 in Montgomery, Alabama, to Lola Mann Jones and James Franklin Jones. He spent his youth in Montgomery. In 1941, Mr. Jones entered flight school. During World War II, he served as a B-25 bomber pilot, flying over fifty missions in Africa and Italy. After World War II, he was employed as a salesman in the aluminum industry. He married Elinor Lyttle Keith in Louisville, Kentucky in 1954. They later resided in California and then in Newnan, Georgia. He has resided at Wesley Woods since 2006.

Mr. Jones was a member of the Newnan Country Club. He was also involved with the Kiwanis Club of Newnan and attended the Newnan Presbyterian Church. He is survived by his daughter, Lauren Jones Robinson, his son-in-law, Perry D. Robinson, and grandchildren Brett Robinson and Taylor Robinson, all of Alexandria, Virginia. There will be an inurnment for Mr. Jones at the Arlington National Cemetery at a time in the near future.
