



Winston Oscar Bullard

November 9, 1930 - March 28, 2010

Winston “Rusty” O. Bullard, age 79, died at his Newnan home on Sunday, March 28, 2010. He was born in Columbia County, GA to the late Oscar Clark Bullard & Annie Haynes Bullard. He received his degree from Mercer School of Pharmacy and became a small business owner and Pharmacist in East Point, where he opened Bullard’s Pharmacy. He also served on the board of Trustees for Mercer University. In his spare time he enjoyed the outdoors, quail hunting with his bird dogs, Mississippi Jake & Jenny. He served in the early 1980’s as the President for the Georgia Pharmaceutical Association. He was a Deacon and taught Sunday school for Dogwood Hills Baptist Church. He relocated to Newnan in 1980 and became a member of First Baptist Church of Newnan where he loved to work at the AO Mission Center. He was actively involved with the East Point Rotary Club. In addition to his parents, he is preceded in death by sister, Jean Crawford. He and his wife, Iris Browning Bullard celebrated their 53rd wedding anniversary on March 17th, just before he went to the hospital and under hospice care.
